Terms and conditions

By submitting an application, entrants are deemed to have accepted the following Terms and Conditions.

1. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this grant, applicants must:

- Be an active MSWA Client member living with a neurological condition. An active Client is defined by anyone who currently receives services or engages with MSWA through an MSWA facilitated program.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Reside in Western Australia.
- Propose a project, activity, or initiative that supports personal interests, goals, or aspirations - aligned with the theme *Life, not Limits*.

2. Grant Amounts

A total of 9 grants will be awarded across three funding tiers:

- 5 grants of \$1,000.
- 2 grants of \$2,500.
- 2 grants of \$5,000.
- Applicants must nominate one of the above grant amounts in their application, based on the scope and scale of their proposed project.
- Grants will be allocated based on the selection panel's discretion.
- Partial funding may be awarded at the discretion of the selection panel.
- Funding is limited and subject to availability.

3. Application Process

To be considered, applicants must submit a completed application form including:

- Confirmation they are an active MSWA Client.
- A clear description of their passion or project.
- How long they have pursued this passion.
- A detailed explanation of how the funds will be used.
- Supporting photos or videos showcasing their passion.
- A short reference from someone who knows them well (e.g., friend, family member, colleague).

All application forms must be submitted either online through the MSWA website www.mswa.org.au or by sending a completed printed form via email to marketing@mswa.org.au. Alternatively, printed forms may be delivered in person to the reception desk at any of the following MSWA Service Centres.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Applications open on Monday, 20 October and close at 4:00PM on Friday, 5 December 2025
- Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Multiple submissions are permitted from the same recipient; only one submission per category is allowed.

4. Selection Criteria

Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the selection panel, based on:

- Clarity and strength of the applicant's passion, goal, or area of interest.
- Potential positive impact on personal growth or quality of life.
- Alignment with the theme *Life, not Limits*.
- Feasibility and clarity of how the grant will be used.

The selection panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

5. Successful Applications

- Successful applicants will be notified by Monday, 12 January 2026 via phone or email.
- Recipients must use the funds as outlined in their application.
- Grants may be provided as a direct reimbursement or as a purchase made on behalf of the recipient.
- Grants are non-transferable and awarded to the individual named in the application.
- Recipients must sign a Grant Agreement.

To claim the grant, recipients must provide:

- Proof of identity (100-point ID check).
- Proof of Western Australian residency.
- An Australian bank account (if applicable).

If any funds are misused or not used in alignment with the intent outlined in the application, MSWA reserves the right to request the return of the grant funds in full or in part.

Failure to provide suitable documentation or comply with the terms may result in forfeiture of the grant.

6. Participation in Marketing and Content

By accepting the grant, recipients agree to reasonably participate in MSWA-related content opportunities, which may include:

- Photography, videography, or written stories for use in MSWA marketing, media, website, social media, or internal communications.

MSWA will work respectfully and collaboratively with recipients to ensure their stories are shared in a way they are comfortable with. A consent form will be required before any content is produced.

7. Privacy and Data Use

All personal information collected during the application process will be handled in accordance with <https://mswa.org.au/privacy-policy>. Information will only be used for the purpose of administering the grant and related promotional activities.

8. Program Changes

MSWA reserves the right to:

- Modify, suspend, or withdraw the grant program at any time.
